

# **AEMT Course FAQ's**

## What is the class?

- The Advanced Emergency Medical Technician certificate program prepares students to provide basic and limited advanced emergency medical care and transportation for critical and emergent patients who access the emergency medical system. This individual possesses the basic knowledge and skills necessary to provide patient care and transportation. Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians function as part of a comprehensive EMS response, under medical oversight. Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians perform interventions with the basic and advanced equipment typically found on an ambulance. The Advanced Emergency Medical Technician is a link from the scene to the emergency health care system. Successful completion of the program allows the graduate to take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians AEMT certification examination and apply for Georgia licensure as an AEMT.
- This class is designed for licensed EMT and EMT-B candidates who are current MAAS employees in good standing.
- Selected candidates will be attending class off-shift. Classes will be designed so that each student will attend two
  days of class per week.

### When?

- The course will be held from April 2, 2018 thru July 13, 2018. The class will run from 9am to 4pm Tuesday thru Friday.
- Students must attend a **Day One** and a **Day Two** each week. Day One is taught on Tuesday or Wednesday and Day Two is taught on Thursday or Friday.

#### Where?

• The class will be held at the *MetroAtlanta* Ambulance HQ in Marietta, GA.

#### Who?

- This course is open to MAAS employees who are currently certified as an EMT or EMT-B.
- Applicants will be screened and selected based on time of service, employment record, and classroom availability.
- All applicants must be employees in good standing.
- Employees attending the course will be required to sign to the tuition reimbursement agreement. Students will not be paid for class hours.
- Course is provided at no out of pocket cost. Employees attending the course will be required to sign to the tuition reimbursement agreement

## How?

- Applicants must download application from the *MetroAtlanta* Ambulance website.
- A notification of your interest must be received by the Academy by March 21, 2018.
- Selected Applicants will be notified as they are accepted.
